Dense red and black fruit aromas, are complexed by nuances of chocolate, vanilla and liquorice. The palate is rich with black fruits, sweet spice and cradled by a nicely toasted oak framework. The soft, ripe tannins complement the wine and support the fruit to a long finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES (JEREMY GORDON)

16 months in oak.

90% French, 10% American, 20% new.

Primary and secondary fermentation in tank, one month on skins.

VITICULTURIST'S COMMENTS (CHRISTO EDWARDS)

Overall, a vintage of extreme weather conditions.

A mild spring with a nice even budburst. December and January had virtually no rain and warmer than average temperatures.

As harvest commenced the region saw significant rainfall which placed disease pressure on all varieties.

Our hard work in the vineyard of intensive shoot thinning and leaf plucking early in the season ensured beautiful ripe Shiraz being delivered to the winery mid April.
