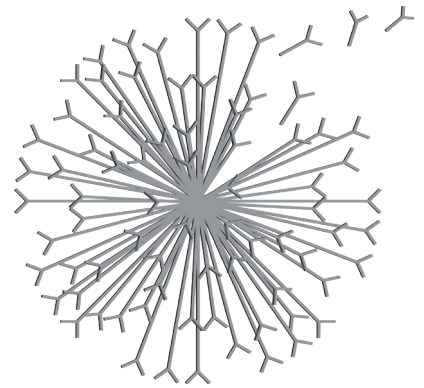

At just 8.0% alcohol, it's a celebration of balance, freshness and wonder of nature.

Tasting Notes

Colour

Starbright white-gold, clear and petillant.

Nose

Lemon zest and lemon meringue, lemon custard and lemon sherbet. As much an effect as an aroma. Wild herbal notes on the wine's event horizon. Impossible to unsmell.

Palate

Pert and bright, refreshing and upright. Immediate. A fine, fine jeweller's hand is at work with the swirling, tiny, multitudinous bubbles – always present yet never in the way. More dry and apple skin savoury than sweet. Indeed, not really sweet at all.

Drink

Drink this with a bottle opener and your dietician. Remind her that this playful wine is only 8.5% fun by volume.

Lemon Myrtle & Aniseed Myrtle.

Alcohol: 8.0% (approx 4.7 standard drinks)
