2025 UPPER TINTARA ROSÉ

BACKGROUND

“This is the inaugural release of our Blewitt Springs Rosé.

The fruit, sourced entirely from our Upper Tintara Vineyard, comes from the new Grenache block which we planted in 2021, and the 1947 planted old vine Cinsault.

We’ve always loved light fruit driven Rosé, and this is our take on that style.”

WINEMAKING

Both the Grenache and Cinsault were hand-picked and whole bunch pressed straight off skins before undergoing cold settling in stainless steel. The wine remained in tank on lees for five months, building texture and palate weight while preserving freshness and purity. The wine was filtered before bottling on the 26th of August 2025.

AROMA	Bright and fragrant, the nose displays notes of fresh red berries, watermelon and subtle pink grapefruit, along with attractive white florals.
PALATE	The palate is crisp, dry and refreshing with fresh raspberries, redcurrants and cranberries. The fruit is supported by zippy acidity and subtle grippy mouthfeel.
