2021 ROSÉ

Although synonymous with great weather and good times, this versatile Cape Landing Rosé delivers far more. We like to think, Provençal with panache! Delicately fruity, tannic strength, complex textures, and natural acidity, ready for any social occasion and a wide range of food pairings, whatever the weather or season.

TASTING NOTES

COLOUR

Rose coral pink.

BOUQUET

Aromas of rose petal and ripe strawberries, cherries and watermelon.

PALATE

Blistering natural acidity, gently intertwined with fine white tannins, provides length to the palate, balanced by a persistent mineral finish of cherry blossoms and citrus.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Pristine Syrah fruit is picked in the cool early hours of morning, gently destemmed and pressed immediately to extract only the purest juice, the most delicate flavours and a blush of colour. The juice is settled overnight before being racked to a long cool ferment in stainless steel, followed by 4 months of fortnightly bâtonnage to extract every last drop of texture, weight and complexity from the fine lees. After aging the wine is blended, lightly fined and filtered before bottling.

VINTAGE DESCRIPTION	A vintage year of extraordinary weather challenges, where early pruning and sustainable viticulture was vital to the growth of quality, balanced fruit. A strong cyclone season resulted in increased rainfall and unusual growing conditions throughout the region, prompting the need for significant canopy management to improve air flow and mitigate risk of disease. Warmer than average weather conditions in December/January assisted fruit ripening but the growing season came to an abrupt end in mid-April when Cyclone Seroja forced a rapid final harvest. Our excellent vineyard management and viticulture team handled the weather and growing conditions with great skill and confidence, allowing us to bring in fruit of superb quality with little-to-no-disease in our vineyards.
